

How does the Office of the City Auditor provide value to Oakland residents?


- Protect against fraud, waste, abuse, and mismanagement

- Assumed Office January 7, 2019

- Authority to audit anything and everything in the City
- Staffing: 10 FTE's
 - > 8 Auditors
 - > 2 Administrative staff
- Office budget of \$2.3 million
- City budget of \$1.6 billion


