ABOUT THE SURVEY

The Office of the City Auditor is conducting an annual risk assessment to develop our annual audit workplan and would like to hear from all Oaklanders. This process includes obtaining input from City leadership, City employees, community organizations, and Oakland residents on the issues, departments, and/or City activities they are most concerned about and want to see audited.

In previous years, our Office issued audits on homeless services, encampment management, fire inspections, and financial conditions, all of which were among the biggest concerns warranting an audit. You can read those reports, and all our other audits and investigations, <u>here</u>.

We will consider your feedback along with other information when developing our annual audit workplan. Other information we consider in developing the audit workplan includes complaints received from our <u>Whistleblower Hotline</u>, issues identified in our audit work, and my Office's resources and workload.

In August, my Office will publish the annual audit workplan in accordance with recent Charter changes resulting from the passing of Measure X. I fully endorsed and lobbied for this requirement to increase transparency and accountability in our Office.

We want to hear from all Oaklanders so we can focus our Office's work on the highest-risk areas of the City.

Thank you for sharing your feedback, insights, concerns, and ideas, which are invaluable in my quest to ensure accountability and integrity in our government.
